<u>The Lord's Supper</u>

I. WE PROCLAIM CHRIST'S DEATH (v. 26)

- A. The observance is a constant reminder of what Jesus did for us.
 - 1) Jesus gave His life and shed His blood (Rom. 5:6-8)
 - 2) What Jesus did for us was a demonstration of His great love for sinful man (John 15:13)
 - 3) What Jesus did by dying on the cross paid our sin debt to God, satisfying God's justice.
 - 4) Christ delivered us from the power and penalty of sin. Sin no longer has control over us. (*Rom. 6:1-14*)

II. WE ANTICIPATE CHRIST'S RETURN

- A. Christ's death on the cross was not the end of Jesus.
- B. Jesus came forth from the grave.
- C. Jesus ascended back to the Father in heaven, promising to return (Acts 1:6-11 | John 14:3)
- D. Scripture repeatedly teaches that Jesus will come again (2 Pet. 2:1-15)
